Coach Pontoons (“Coach”), 1505 13th Street North, Humboldt, IA 50548, (515) 573-1093 provides the following limited warranties to the original purchaser of the covered Coach boat (“Vessel”) and any permitted transferees (referred to collectively herein as “You” and “Your”) subject to the terms, conditions, limitations, and exclusions set forth herein.

1. Lifetime Structural Limited Warranty: Coach warrants that the main welded seams of Your Vessel will be free from defects in materials and/or workmanship for as long as You own the Vessel. Main welded seams include: pontoon assembly, deck risers, railing, and motor mount. This lifetime limited warranty begins on the invoice date for the sale of the Vessel to the original purchaser. In the event the main welded seams of Your Vessel incur a defect in materials and/or workmanship within the applicable time period Coach will pay or reimburse You for the cost of repair from a Coach-authorized repair facility.

2. Plywood Decking and Floors Lifetime Limited Warranty: Coach warrants that all plywood decking and pontoon flooring of Your Vessel will be free from defects in materials and/or workmanship, fungal decay/rot, and damage by termites as long as you own the Vessel. In the event the plywood decking and pontoon flooring of Your Vessel incurs a defect in materials and/or workmanship Coach will pay or reimburse You for the cost of repair from a Coach-authorized repair facility. This warranty does not apply to damage caused by swelling, shrinkage, and/or discoloration; inherent wood characteristics such as checking, leafing, splitting, and broken grain.

3. Floor Vinyl 10-year Limited Warranty: Coach warrants that the vinyl flooring material of the Vessel will be free from defects in materials and/or workmanship and will not fade or fail for a period of 10 years from the invoice date for the sale of the Vessel to the original purchaser. Damage caused by rips, tears, snags, stains, unraveling, overexposure to the sun, as a result of improperly covering the Vessel or other abuse is not covered under this warranty. In the event of a defect in materials and/or workmanship within the applicable time period, vinyl of comparable value and color will be supplied as a replacement for the affected area and Coach will pay or reimburse You for the cost of repair from a Coach-authorized repair facility. In the event of a valid warranty claim, no shipping charges will be covered.

4. Vinyl Fabric 10-year Limited Warranty: Coach warrants that the coated fabrics will remain free from defects in materials and/or workmanship for a period of 10 years from the invoice date for the sale of the Vessel to the original purchaser. In the event of a defect in materials and/or workmanship within the applicable time period, vinyl of comparable value and color will be supplied as a replacement for the affected area and Coach will pay or reimburse You for the cost of repair from a Coach-authorized repair facility. In the event of a valid warranty claim, no shipping charges will be covered.

5. Component Parts Not Covered: This warranty does not cover: painting, powder coating or protective finishes, graphics, or aluminum deterioration by chemical actions or damage due to electrolysis (caused by, but not limited to, such things as metal attachments to the Vessel, storage, battery acid spillage, or use of improper anti-fouling paints). Additional component warranties may be provided by the respective manufacturers and Coach will not be responsible for any such warranties. These warranties are available in the owner's packet or by contacting Coach's customer service department.

6. Component Parts 10-year Limited Warranty: Coach warrants that all other items not specifically addressed in paragraphs 1 through 5 and that are not covered by a component manufacturer warranty will be free from defects in materials and/or workmanship for a period of ten (10) years, beginning on the invoice date for the sale of the Vessel to the original purchaser. In the event any of the covered component parts of Your Vessel incurs a defect in materials and/or workmanship within the applicable time period, Coach will pay or reimburse You for the cost of repair from a Coach-authorized repair facility, including parts and labor. No shipping charges will be covered.

IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARISING UNDER STATE LAW, INCLUDING THE WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY AND THE WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, ARE LIMITED IN DURATION TO THE TERMS OF THESE EXPRESS WARRANTIES. WHERE SUCH LIMITATION IS PERMITTED, COACH PONTOONS SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OF USE OF ANY PRODUCT, LOSS OF TIME, INCONVENIENCE OR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WITH RESPECT TO BUSINESS PROPERTY, WHETHER AS A RESULT OF BREACH OF WARRANTY, NEGLIGENCE OR OTHERWISE. Some states do not allow (a) limitations on how long an applied warranty lasts or (b) the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you. THIS WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS, AND YOU MAY ALSO HAVE OTHER RIGHTS, WHICH MAY VARY FROM STATE TO STATE.

7. Consumer Responsibility: The warranty registration located on Coach's website (coachpontoons.com) is to be completed by the consumer and selling dealer within 30 days after purchase. While warranty registration is not mandatory for your coverage under Coach's warranty it will, however, expedite your receipt of warranty service and will aid Coach in contacting you quickly should the need arise to advise you of any safety notification.

8. How to Make a Claim: All claims under these limited warranties must be submitted in writing directly to an authorized Coach Dealer, with a copy sent to Warranty Department, Coach Pontoons, 1505 13th Street North, Humboldt, Iowa 50548, stating the Hull Identification Number of the product, proof of purchase, name of the authorized dealer from whom you purchased, the date of purchase, and a complete and accurate description, including photographs of the claimed defect. For assistance in making a claim or if there is not an authorized Coach Dealer near you, please call Coach at (515) 573-1093. Upon receipt of the warranty claim, Coach will investigate the claimed defect. If it is established to Coach's satisfaction that the defect falls within the provisions of its warranty, the defective part, article, or product must be delivered to an authorized Coach Dealer, or to the factory at its request, for repair. **Freight charges to and from the dealer or factory shall be borne by the Vessel owner.**

9. How to Transfer this Warranty: These limited warranties are transferable to any subsequent owner of the Vessel, subject to current applicable warranty transfer fee to the terms, conditions, exclusions, and limitations stated herein. **The subsequent owner must initiate the warranty transfer process no later than 90 days after receiving ownership of the Vessel and will be responsible for paying the transfer fee in full at the time of transfer. For more information on the transfer process and applicable fees, or to initiate a transfer, contact Coach at (515) 573-1093.**

10. Exclusions & Limitations: In addition to the exclusion specific to each of the above warranties, these warranties also do not extend to any damage due to the negligence by You or by others, lack of normal maintenance of the product, unreasonable use, accidents, abuse, alterations, improper cleaning, improper installation, repair work completed by any party other than a Coach-authorized repair facility, ordinary wear and tear, improper trailering, use of the product for racing purposes, commercial uses other than those expressly stated herein, and exceeding horsepower ratings. **Without limiting cases of misuse and neglect, it is understood that the failure to operate at reduced speeds in rough water shall constitute misuse. These warranties only apply to Vessels manufactured after September 1, 2017. NO WARRANTIES ARE MADE FOR PRODUCTS SOLD OUTSIDE THE NORTH AMERICAN CONTINENT.**

- A. **Limitations Applicable to Boat Clubs and Fractional Ownership:** For a Vessel that is part of a Boat Club or subject to Fractional Ownership, the warranties identified in paragraphs 1-4 and 6 shall be limited to a term of 3 years or 350 engine hours, whichever occurs first, provided both the Vessel and motor were purchased directly from Coach as a package. This warranty may be transferable to subsequent owners of the Vessel, and individual, non-commercial owners may be entitled to the full remaining term of the applicable warranties as determined by Coach on a case-by-case basis subject to Vessel inspection by Coach and payment of applicable warranty transfer fees. Coach reserves the right to decline transfer of the warranty for such Vessels on a case-by-case basis.
- B. **Limitations Applicable to Rental Fleets:** For a Vessel that is part of a rental fleet, the warranties identified in paragraphs 1-4 and 6 shall be limited to a term of 2 years or 250 engine hours, whichever occurs first, provided both the Vessel and motor were purchased directly from Coach as a package. This warranty may be transferable to subsequent owners of the Vessel, and individual, non-commercial owners may be entitled to the full remaining term of the applicable warranties as determined by Coach on a case-by-case basis subject to Vessel inspection by Coach and payment of applicable warranty transfer fees. Coach reserves the right to decline transfer of the warranty for such Vessels on a case-by-case basis.
